

Athena Mavridou holds a BSc in Biology, an MSc in Ecology, and a doctorate in Water Microbiology. She has published over 60 research papers, three books, a chapter in the WHO Guidelines on recreational water quality, numerous Technical Reports assigned and published by UNEP/WHO, and around 200 presentations and posters in national and international conferences. She has coordinated about 50 research projects in the field of water microbiology, focusing on recreational waters and Legionella detection, prevention and control. As a WHO scientific expert she has organized seminars, training courses and proficiency testing schemes, including practical laboratory exercises, in Malta, Kuwait, Iran, Algeria, Montenegro and Greece. She is currently working on the new edition of the WHO Guidelines on Pool and Spa environments. She served on the Technical Committee for the accreditation of water microbiology laboratories of the National Accreditation Agency. She received an award from the Athens Academy for her contribution to scientific work. She is an Associate Editor of Water, Science and Technology and referee to a number of scientific journals. She organized the 15th HRWM Conference in Naxos, Greece (2009). She is currently Professor of Environmental Microbiology, Technological Educational Institution, Athens, Greece.
