

Regina Sommer is Associate Professor at the Medical University Vienna, Austria, at the Institute for Hygiene and Applied Immunology. She is head of the unit Water Hygiene and leads beside her activities in teaching and research the accredited Laboratory and Inspection Body "Hygiene Vienna" at the Medical University. Together with the Austrian Institute of Technology and the Department of Medical Physics, Veterinary University Vienna, Regina runs as "UV Team Austria" a Test Facility for UV disinfection systems at the Water Test Centre Wiental. She is convenor of the Austrian drinking water commission and member of the Advisory Board for Bathing Water Hygiene of the Ministry of Health. In 2012 she has been appointed as president of the Austrian Society for Hygiene, Microbiology and Preventive Medicine.

Regina studied Food- and Biotechnology at the University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Sciences, Vienna, and did her PhD at the Medical University Vienna. In 1999 she received her Venia docendi and was appointed as Associate Professor in 2000. As further professional qualifications Regina is state authorized by the Ministry of Health as assessor for water hygiene.
